

EMPRESS MAKING CHANGES AFTER BREAK UP

A card-by-card teaching guide to the spread in the video. Read it alongside the reading to learn each card as it lands.

16 cards · up to 10 on screen at once · reading order

HOW TO READ THIS SPREAD

This is a **flowing spread**, not a fixed cross. The reader pulls cards as she speaks, and up to **10** stay on the board at once so a whole thought stays visible before older cards step aside.

Each card below is numbered in the **order it first appears** in the reading. The two highlighted words are the card's core meaning; under them is **what the reader actually said** when she turned that card, taken straight from this reading.

The video placed cards across **282** spoken beats. The same 16 cards, taught one screen at a time, are gathered here so you can study them after the read.

THE CARDS, IN READING ORDER

Queen of Cups

compassion empathy

We have the six of pinnacles, the card, and then the nine of sword. Look like the card is really going through it because of something that was balanced out. Somebody received something they deserve. I mean, let me get something with this six of pinnacles. Is this six of pinnacles good? Because why would the queen of pinnacles is actually facing the six of pinnacles? It seems to be a positive thing because otherwise the card would not be worried.

Nine of Swords

anxiety worry

What's the card then?

The Emperor

authority structure

Let me get something with the six of pinnacles, and it's the card. So the card is receiving something, or it's something that's fairly going to them. It says if somebody has to move forward, this queen of cups is worried that they have to move forward away from the card. The card is getting what they deserve.

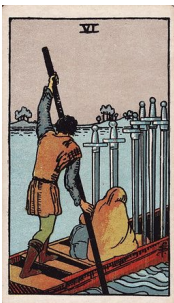


Three of Wands

expansion foresight

That's the same the card that came out up there. We have the night of wands. And then we have the two of us, or somebody does not want to go. They do not want to leave. They don't want to lose their man or their woman to some other person.

Six of Swords

transition moving on

We have the card's energy. So they're going.

Two of Cups

partnership union

And we have the card, and this is some type of relationship.

Five of Wands

conflict competition

The nine of pinnacles look like somebody fighting over resources, fighting over money. First card in this world was the card. Last card was a ten.

The Empress

nurturing abundance

They look like the card is the card tried everything. So it looked like maybe the card was trying to tap into the queen of cubs side. Like, I think it might have been too late to show that care or that love or that connection is something that was missing. It's something that was missing. I mean, just because it says The Emperor and the card out here, it don't mean that they're meant to be together. I mean, mind you, they're in two different decks.

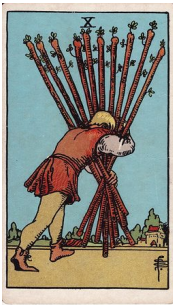


Queen of Wands

confidence warmth

Ten of Wands

burden responsibility

Like when you're trying to fight, you know people that let's say fighting as a sport, people usually give the card. They're trying to win. You know what I'm saying? It was giving The Empress queen of wands in the second line with all these five of wands and the card. It's like a lot of fire. You know, and the card sometimes can be very destructive.

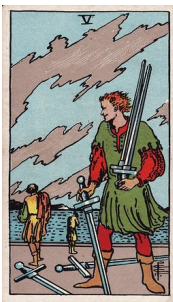


Nine of Wands

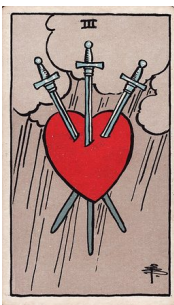


Five of Swords

heartbreak and **sorrow**. The reader did not dwell on this card; read it by that core meaning where it sits in the spread.

Yeah, we got the card at the bottom. It was something that they did not know. It doesn't look like they were giving queen of cubs in their relationship.

Judgement

reckoning awakening

reckoning and **awakening**. The reader did not dwell on this card; read it by that core meaning where it sits in the spread.

Seven of Cups

choices illusion

Somebody got to come out of the illusion. Okay, that may be another thing. The card can be illusions, delusions, fantasies. Okay, fog. When you just can't really see, it's something that needs to be cleared up. I really do think so.
