A card-by-card teaching guide to the spread in the video. Read it alongside the reading to learn each card as it lands.

22 cards · up to 10 on screen at once · reading order

HOW TO READ THIS SPREAD

This is a **flowing spread**, not a fixed cross. The reader pulls cards as she speaks, and up to **10** stay on the board at once so a whole thought stays visible before older cards step aside.

Each card below is numbered in the **order it first appears** in the reading. The two highlighted words are the card's core meaning; under them is **what the reader actually said** when she turned that card, taken straight from this reading.

The video placed cards across **284** spoken beats. The same 22 cards, taught one screen at a time, are gathered here so you can study them after the read.

Nine of Cups

wishes contentment

We have The Magician, the card, and we have Justice. Like they're about to make something real or they already did. The card is someone feeling really good about themselves. 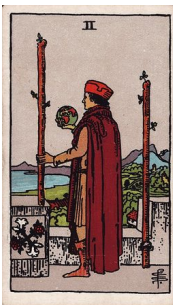


Six of Cups

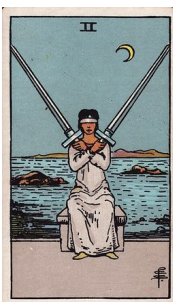


The World

grief and loss. The reader did not dwell on this card; read it by that core meaning where it sits in the spread.

restriction fear

Wow. What is that? That looked like somebody being trapped. We have the queen of pinnacles. With this to a sword, five of cups, the card. What's this energy? That looks terrible. We have the six of finicles here. They may open the doors to this person so they can receive.

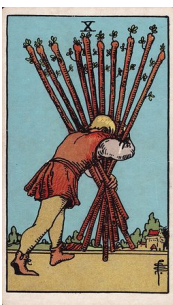


Five of Wands

And then we have the card and change something to a positive energy here.

willpower and **drive**. The reader did not dwell on this card; read it by that core meaning where it sits in the spread.

emotional mastery calm

Water signs. We have the eight of thinicles here. It's something about perfect. You know, something about their profession. Something they're perfecting or they do well or they're going to do well. Like, what is this energy here? The card is doing something in their profession.

The High Priestess

intuition the unseen

We have the card and the card can see they know the truth. What is this energy? They're both in a beautiful position and they both have the card. Between them, like they know the truth. They know the secret. They know they hidden. That's crazy. I mean, that's amazing. I shouldn't keep saying that's crazy. It's just like, wow, it's a lot right now. What is this energy? What is this guy? It says healing energy, Lord, healing energy and angelic protection.

The Empress

nurturing abundance

The High Priestess and the card could be like a motherly figure or definitely a boss figure. But something about like, you know, the garden and the flourishing and different plants and animals and fruits and vegetables and the running stream in here. What is this energy?

Queen of Cups

compassion empathy

The card is The Empress and The High Priestess is in the middle of both of them. So it's like it's something that's deeply understood between the king and the card. And it might not even be that they're water signs, but on a spiritual level. It's on another level. This is crazy and it's stable. I mean, what can I say? It's something that's stable. It's something that's been stabilized. That's amazing.
