

YOU'RE STEPPING INTO A HIGHER TITLE

A card-by-card teaching guide to the spread in the video. Read it alongside the reading to learn each card as it lands.

16 cards · up to 10 on screen at once · reading order

HOW TO READ THIS SPREAD

This is a **flowing spread**, not a fixed cross. The reader pulls cards as she speaks, and up to **10** stay on the board at once so a whole thought stays visible before older cards step aside.

Each card below is numbered in the **order it first appears** in the reading. The two highlighted words are the card's core meaning; under them is **what the reader actually said** when she turned that card, taken straight from this reading.

The video placed cards across **119** spoken beats. The same 16 cards, taught one screen at a time, are gathered here so you can study them after the read.

THE CARDS, IN READING ORDER

The High Priestess

intuition the unseen

We have The Chariot, we have the Hierophon, and we have the card, wow, okay. They're balanced, they are controlled, they are disciplined, they are aligned, like they're inner and outer because the card is like what you know on the inside, it's the hidden knowledge on the inside and the Hierophon knows the knowledge on the outside and The Chariot moves everything forward, it aligns everything.

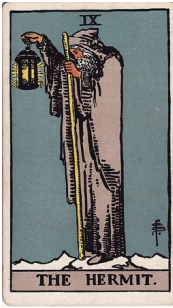


The Chariot

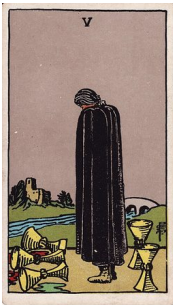


Two of Wands

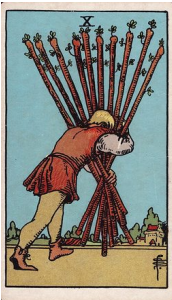


The Lovers

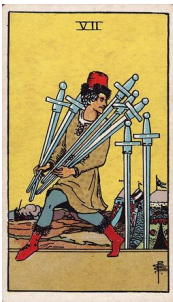


Ten of Cups
